Outside of school I enjoy playing netball and going to the gym to keep fit! I am also a huge bookworm, and enjoy going to watch musicals!

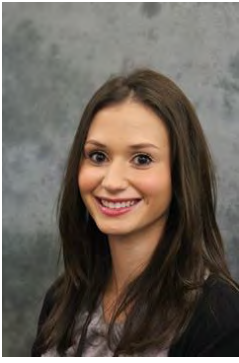


Miss Costello - Head of Parks House
