





You can click on the link in the email to join the meeting. Or you can click on the link in 'posts' in your class team to join the meeting.






On teams you will be able to:








Getting started in teams...





Click on the team for your subject class to get started.


Notifications/messages from your teacher appear as numbers in red.

Other students will see your initials.




Your teacher can praise you and say how totally awesome you are!






You can view your Learning Checklists for each subject by using the menu to the left...


Remember our Class Code for working online Online learning spaces should be safe places to be.
