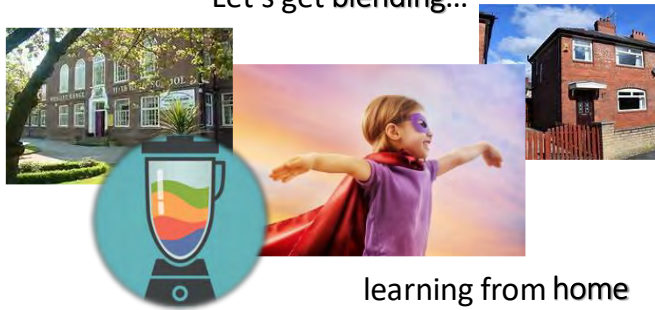


Let's get blending...
