Qualification Content

Pearson Qualification Structure

There are THREE units that you will be covering. These are:

- Component 1 Human Lifespan Development (Course work)
- Component 2 Service and Values in HSC (Course work and a practical assessment)
- Component 3 Health and Well-being (Exam in February and May of year 11)

Component 1: Human Lifespan Development

(coursework assessed)

- How do people grow and develop throughout their lives?
- How can factors such as lifestyle choices, relationships and lifestyle events affect your growth and development?
- This unit will allow you to explore these issues and to investigate how these factors are interrelated.

Component 3: Health and wellbeing

(exam assessed; a 2 hours exam)

- This unit builds on knowledge learned in Components 1 and 2 and enables you to be bring these together and related to a real-life situation.
- You will need to assess an individual's health and wellbeing and use this to create an improvement
- You will need knowledge about a variety of health conditions and how to improve these as well as positive life style choices for the best possible health and well-being.


