

## Your status is **DIGITAL**



There is **NO** physical document, for example, a Residence card or letter, to prove your immigration status in the UK

## Login to your digital status:

GOV.UK

Go to [gov.uk/view-your-settled-status](https://www.gov.uk/view-your-settled-status) to access your status



Or search “View and prove your settled status” online

## When logged in you can:

### Update your details



Your telephone number, email address, address, name or surname and provide your new passport or ID details

### Prove your status

SHARE CODE

Generate a “Share code” and provide it to your, for example, employer so they can check your immigration status in the UK



Or you can enter, for example, your employer’s email address and they will receive your “Share code” automatically

## Who must apply?



All EU, EEA and EFTA\* citizens, and their family members living in the UK, must have pre-settled or settled status after **30 June 2021**

## EUSS

To confirm your status, you must apply to the EU Settlement scheme (EUSS)

## What happens if you don't apply?



You will lose the right to work in the UK, use the NHS for free, enrol in education, access public funds such as benefits and travel, if you do not apply

## What status you can apply for?

5+  
years in  
the UK

**Settled status** (Indefinite Leave to Remain) is for those EU citizens and their family members who have lived in the UK for 5 years or more when they apply

-5  
years in  
the UK

**Pre-settled status** (Limited Leave to Remain) is for those who have not lived in the UK for 5 years when they apply



Pre-settled status is valid for 5 years only. You will need to **reapply** and obtain settled status when you reach 5 years of residency in the UK

## What do you need to apply?



A valid passport or national ID card

NINO

National insurance number



Birth certificates/other documents to show family connection



You may be required to provide documents to prove how long you've lived in the UK e.g. P60, P45, Council Tax Bills, or a letter from schools/universities



Telephone and email address

## How to apply?



Check if your passport or ID has a **biometric** symbol



If ID document biometric, then download a free **EU Exit: ID document check** app to your smartphone and apply



If not biometric, then apply **online** on [gov.uk/settled-status-eu-citizens-families](https://gov.uk/settled-status-eu-citizens-families)

FREE

It's FREE to apply to the scheme

## Applying for your children



When you apply for your child you can 'link' their application to yours



If your child was born in the UK but is not a British citizen, they will still need to apply

## After you have applied

UAN

You will receive your 16-digit unique application number (UAN) from the Home Office (HO) via email



The HO may request further information, for example, documents to prove your residency in the UK



You will receive your Certificate of application (COA) and your Status outcome letter from the HO to your email

## How long will it take?



Application processing times vary based on individual circumstances
