## Catch Up funding Plan 2019-2020 - Review September 2020

## **Objectives:**

- To improve the reading ages of the 66 students with a reading age of 9.5-11 years to above 11 years.
- To improve the reading ages of the 26 students with a reading age of 8-9.4 years to above 9.5 years.
- To improve the reading age of the 13 students with a reading age below 8 years to above 8 years.
- For the 35 students with a KS2 scaled score of 91-99 to be on target in maths and improve to a NC L4b.
- For the 28 S1 S3 students to improve their English to above S3.

Following the national Lockdown Year 7 students were completing home learning and did not return to school during the rest of the academic year. This had a severe impact on the majority of the programmes below as most involve teacher support and so the majority of impact can only be reported up to the start of the national lockdown.
