SSLT Team	ELY/OBA	This is the Senior Student Leadership Team. The team is made up of year 11 students: Head Girl, Deputy Head Girl and SSLT members. They will oversee and help to train the rest of the student leaders in the main school. They will plan and deliver initiatives for the school and at school events. They will consult with students and liaise with staff to make further positive changes in their school community.
Year Leaders	ELY/HOY/HCO	Year leaders will be responsible for carrying out morning and break duties, to support their year office. They will also plan and deliver charity events, to raise money for the school charity: Woodstreet Mission. They will assist the HOY in presenting year assemblies.
