

Whalley Range Sixth Form Parent/Carer Home Sixth Form Agreement

The learning agreement is intended to give parents/carers a clear understanding of what you can expect from the Sixth Form and what the Sixth Form will expect from parents/carers to support your daughter while at Whalley Range Sixth Form.

Under this agreement the Sixth Form will provide:

- Under this agreement the Sixth Form will provide:
- A programme of courses that is delivered by highly qualified and effective members of staff.
- A friendly, caring and supportive environment.
- Structured independent learning resources for each subject your daughter studies.
- Work submitted by your daughter to be marked promptly and detailed feedback to be given.
- Rigorous assessment, appraisal and opportunity for reflection on individual progress.
- A Form Tutor who will monitor her progress and provide guidance in setting targets for improvement.
- A structured tutorial and personal development programme to provide guidance for progression and her future development.
- Dedicated Sixth Form facilities and access to ICT which actively encourages independent learning.
- Opportunities for parents/carers to come to school to discuss their daughter's progress.
- Regular progress reports.
- Entry for external examinations subject to meeting Student Learning Agreement requirements.

In return parents/carers will be expected to:

- Support your daughter to make the most of her time in the Sixth Form.
- Provide a quiet working space in order for her to complete homework and independent learning.
 Where this is not possible encourage her to make use of the resources within Sixth Form or the local library.
- Encourage your daughter to use her independent learning time effectively and complete a minimum
 of 5 hours of independent learning weekly for each subject studied.
- Ensure your daughter attends all 8:30am morning tutorials, assemblies and timetabled lessons including RISE & Personal Development and fully complies with the attendance and punctuality policy.
- Communicate any reasons for your daughter's absence to college by 9am on the day of the absence.
- Attend parents'/carers' evening with your daughter each year.
- Ensure that medical appointments are made outside of Sixth Form time.
- Agree not to take holidays/periods of absence during term time under any circumstances.
- Accept responsibility for the effect on your daughters' outcomes and progression should the above conditions not be met.
