

Whalley Range Sixth Form Parent/Carer Home Sixth Form Agreement

The learning agreement is intended to give parents/carers a clear understanding of what you can expect from the Sixth Form and what the Sixth Form will expect from parents/carers to support your daughter while at Whalley Range Sixth Form.

Under this agreement you as your daughters parent/carer will be expected to:

Excellence

- Read the Parent/Carer Handbook.
- Support your daughter to make the most of her time in the Sixth Form and maintain high levels of attendance and punctuality.
- Encourage your daughter to use her independent learning time effectively and complete a **minimum of 5 hours** of independent learning weekly for each subject studied.
- Ensure your daughter arrives at least 15 minutes before the start of her exams.
- Ensure your daughter attends all 8:30am morning tutorials, assemblies and timetabled lessons including RISE and fully complies with the attendance and punctuality policy.

Care

- Provide a quiet working space to support her in completing homework and independent study. If this is not possible, ensure she makes use of the Sixth Form study area or the local library.
- Support your daughter to achieve high levels of Attitude to Learning, Attitude to Homework and behaviour.
- Communicate any reasons for your daughter's absence to college **by 9am** on the day of the absence.
- Attend parents'/carers' evening with your daughter each year.
- Ensure that medical appointments are made outside of Sixth Form time.

Respect

- Sign up to Edulinkone and ensure we have correct contact details allowing us to contact you.
- Agree not to take holidays/periods of absence during term time under any circumstances.

- Enrichment and opportunities to engage with employers and universities.
- Dedicated Sixth Form facilities and access to ICT which actively encourages independent learning.
