

Whalley Range Sixth Form Student Learning Agreement

The learning agreement is intended to give students a clear understanding of what they can expect from the Sixth Form and what the Sixth Form will expect from all students.

Under this agreement the Sixth Form will provide:

- A programme of courses that is delivered by highly qualified and effective members of staff.
- A friendly, caring and supportive environment.
- Structured independent learning resources for each subject you study.
- Work submitted by you to be marked promptly and detailed feedback to be given.
- Rigorous assessment, appraisal and opportunity for reflection on individual progress.
- A Form Tutor who will monitor your progress and provide guidance in setting targets for improvement.
- A structured tutorial and personal development programme to provide guidance for progression and your future development.
- Dedicated Sixth Form facilities and access to ICT which actively encourages independent learning.
- Opportunities for your parents/carers to come to school to discuss your progress.
- Regular progress reports.
- Entry for external examinations subject to meeting Student Learning Agreement requirements.

In return you will be expected to:

- Be determined to make the most of your time in the Sixth Form.
- Accept responsibility for your own learning with the support of your Form Tutor and subject teacher.
- Use your independent learning time effectively and complete <u>a minimum</u> of 5 hours of independent learning weekly for each subject studied.
- Complete all work to the required standard and meet all deadlines.
- Attend all 8:30am morning tutorial lessons, assemblies and timetabled lessons including RISE and Personal Development and fully comply with the attendance and punctuality policy. If you know you will be absent, you must inform us and make arrangements to complete any missed work.
- Ensure my conduct meets the expectations of the college Attitude to Learning criteria and I am fully prepared for all lessons by having the appropriate resources.
- To only use mobile devices in the Sixth Form area.
- Attend academic tutorial / parents' evening with a parent or carer.
- Ensure that medical appointments are made outside of Sixth Form time.
- Agree not to take holidays during term time under any circumstances.
- Respect the individual rights of all members of the school community and behave appropriately.
- Provide leadership and act as a role model for younger pupils in the school, showcasing equality and respect, taking responsibility for the school environment.
- Wear appropriate smart casual dress.
- To engage with the personal development and enrichment programme.
- Accept that if the above conditions are not met this will affect your bursary eligibility and your progression to Year 13.
