

## Whalley Range Sixth Form Student Learning Agreement

This agreement outlines what you can expect from the Sixth Form and what is expected of you as a student.

## Under this agreement you will be expected to:

#### **Excellence**

- Be determined to make the most of your time in the Sixth Form.
- Complete <u>a minimum</u> of 5 hours of independent learning weekly for each subject studied. (Level 2 & Level 3 Diploma 10 hours)
- Complete all work to a high standard and meet all deadlines.
- To be available to attend college between 8:30am and 3:45pm each day.
- Attend all 8:30am morning tutorial lessons, assemblies and timetabled lessons including RISE and fully
  comply with attendance and punctuality expectations. If you know you will be absent, you must inform us and
  make arrangements to complete any missed work.
- To check your emails and teams pages daily and regularly check EdulikOne for important information.
- Provide leadership and act as a role model for younger pupils in the school, showcasing equality and respect, taking responsibility for the school environment.

#### Care

- Attend academic tutorial / parents' evening with a parent or carer.
- Ensure that medical appointments are made outside of Sixth Form time.
- Agree not to take holidays during term time under any circumstances.
- Wear appropriate smart casual dress, with your lanyard fully visible.
- To sign in on Inventry on arrival to college and sign out should you leave college during the day.
- To engage with the personal development and enrichment programme.

#### Respect

- Accept responsibility for your own learning with the support of your Form Tutor and subject teacher.
- Ensure my conduct meets the expectations of the college Attitude to Learning & Attitude to Homework criteria and I am fully prepared for all lessons by having the appropriate resources.
- To only use mobile devices in 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of G Block.
- Respect the individual rights of all members of the school community and behave appropriately.
- To respect your Sixth Form environment and all members of the community.
- Arrive at least 15 minutes before the start of all exams.
