## Year 12

- Half Termly meeting with Ms Pym (Head of Social Science) who leads our programme.
- Sutton Trust Pathways to Law - The Pathways to Law programme runs over two academic years. Students therefore leave with a wealth of experiences and opportunities. Students are also eligible for a contextual offer if they complete the programme.
- EPQ – Extended Project Qualification – Equivalent to an AS grade it is an opportunity to demonstrate and develop academic writing skills.
- Early Careers Foundation - two-year virtual mentoring programme for Year 12 students where you will develop professional skills whilst you are completing your A-Levels.
- Court room visit.

## Year 13

- Personal Statement support – The Sixth Form team provide one-to-one support to ensure students create a well-crafted, standout personal statement.
- UCAS Application support – The Sixth Form team provide one-to-one support supporting students with all parts of their application.
- University of Oxford Corpus Christi Visit – Students receive a tour of the campus and given the opportunity to attend lectures and speak to representatives of the University.
- LNAT National Admissions Test for Law – Students are offered support and advice for entrance examinations.
- Interview support – Students will have at least 2 one-to-one interviews.
