We understand the competitive nature of this career path and provide our students with one-to-one support with personal statements, MMI & interview practice and BMAT/UKCAT advice to ensure they stand out and impress universities.

Year 12

- Fortnightly meeting with Dr Sadler who leads our programme.
- Whalley Range Alumnae talks from ex-students currently studying these courses.
- University medical and dental school talks – advice and guidance for students on what they should be doing in year 12 to give themselves the best opportunity for a successful application.
- University & Apprenticeship Fair – Students speak face to face with university medical/dental schools.
- Personal Statement support – The Sixth Form team provide one-to-one support to ensure students create a well-crafted, standout personal statement.

Year 13

- EPQ – Extended Project Qualification – Equivalent to an AS grade it is an opportunity to demonstrate and develop academic writing skills.
- UCAS Application support – The Sixth Form team provide one-to-one support supporting students with all parts of their application.
- BMAT/UKCAT Support – Students are offered support and advice for BMAT and UKCAT exams.
- Interview/MMI support – Students will have at least 2 one-to-one interviews and support preparing for MMIs.
- UpLearn – Students have access to online tutoring software to support their independent learning in science, maths and psychology.
