From the start of your 12 to taking your place at University Whalley Range Sixth Form Pathway Programmes support you every step of the way

At Whalley Range Sixth Form we provide outstanding opportunities for students aspiring to study at the University of Cambridge or University of Oxford. We understand the competitive nature of this and provide our students with one-to-one support with personal statements, interview practice and entrance examination advice to ensure they stand out and impress universities.

## Year 12

- Fortnightly meeting with Mrs Shackleton (Cambridge Alumnae) who leads our programme.
- Oxford University Foundation Year Programme – Students can speak to a representative from the University in college.
- University of Oxford Corpus Christi Visit – Students receive a tour of the campus and given the opportunity to attend lectures and speak to representatives of the University.
- EPQ – Extended Project Qualification – Equivalent to an AS grade it is an opportunity to demonstrate and develop academic writing skills.
- Personal Statement support – The Sixth Form team provide one-to-one support to ensure students create a well-crafted, standout personal statement.

## Year 13

- UCAS Application support – The Sixth Form team provide one-to-one support supporting students with all parts of their application.
- Entrance Examination Support – Students are offered support and advice for entrance examinations.
- Oxbridge entrance examinations – Whalley Range Sixth Form – Whalley Range hosts Oxbridge access exams for students so they are not required to travel.
- Interview/MMI support – Students will have at least 2 one-to-one interviews and support preparing for MMIs.
- UpLearn – Students have access to online tutoring software to support their independent learning in science, maths and psychology.
